#### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

Kern COG staff identified a need of over \$300 million for 7 projects considered ready for construction over the next 5 years. Several of these projects have been ready but not advanced due to funding delays for several years. Kern's regional maximum target is estimated at \$98.8 million. The project cost needs for each project to advance to construction are as follows:

Westside Parkway	\$170,400,000
State Route 46-Segment 3	24,900,000
Seventh Standard Road	22,500,000
West Ridgecrest Blvd.	15,750,000
Dennison Road	20,000,000
Route 46 (In Wasco)	51,000,000
Laval Road at Interstate 5	2,500,000.

The approved project list indicated below maximizes the use of other funding sources, contributes to the equitable distribution of funds throughout the region and is consistent with established regional priorities. The Kern Council of Governments Board of Directors unanimously approved the following program of projects on March 15, 2007. The Program of Projects summary is comprised of the following:

#### **REQUESTED ACTION**

The Kern Council of Governments Board of Directors took action on March 15, 2007 authorizing the submittal of the above program of projects and additionally gave Kern COG staff direction to further collaborate with California Transportation Commission staff on the issue of fully funding the Westside Parkway should the maximum target not be available or full funding of the Westside Parkway not be available. The Kern Council of Governments submittal does not include a partnership entry for State Route 395 in Inyo County. While staff tentatively agreed to possibly fund approximately \$660,000 to the Olancha-Cartago project, the information did not make it through to the Board of Directors or into the staff report. Should there be an opportunity to revisit this option and amend this item later, Kern COG staff will seek that opportunity to do so. The needs of projects in Inyo and Mono require "IIP" commitments; those commitments were not forthcoming in the early stages of the augmentation process. Revisions to Transportation Enhancement programming are not included in this submittal.

Kern COG staff and the City of Bakersfield are ready to fully cooperate with California Transportation Commission staff to provide whatever follow-up information may be required to maximize the opportunity to fund over and above the county share. The Westside Parkway fact and funding sheets identify a realistic project delivery timeline. Should Commission staff require additional information or request modification to this program of projects, Kern COG staff stands ready to work with project managers and Commission staff to provide additional information as required.

#### **PROJECT OVERVIEW**

<u>Westside Parkway</u>: The current request of \$170,400,000 for the Westside Parkway would fully fund final construction work for all segments of this project. The City of Bakersfield has requested this amount beginning in 2008-09 and ending in 2010-11. The environmental review of this project is federally approved.

Additional Needs \$170,400,000 Current Programming \$148,600,000 PUC Grant \$5,000,000

State Route 46 Widening from Keck's Road to State Route 33 / Segment III: Segment III is currently programmed for design and rights-of-way work only and needs additional funding for construction. This project received \$45 million from the Prop 1b, Congestion Mitigation Improvement Account program. The augmentation proposal for \$24.9 million will fully fund the project and construction could begin in 2010. The environmental review of this project is federally approved. Segments 1 and 2 are currently programmed to begin construction in 2008 and 2009. All 3 segments are beneficiaries of a federal transportation-funding earmark.

Additional Needs \$24,900,000 Current Programming \$7,772,000 CMIA \$45,000,000

Seventh Standard Road Widening from Santa Fe Way to Coffee Road —The environmental review of this project is federally approved. Design and rights of way for this project should give way to the start of construction by the proposed 2009 year. Federal demonstration funding was proposed to meet the additional need of \$22.5 million for this project. A conditional proposal by the Cities of Bakersfield and Shafter stipulated that federal demonstration funding will be used for this project if the Westside Parkway were to receive full funding from the 2006 STIP Augmentation. Should full funding not be realized for the Westside Parkway, a proportioned commitment would be offered.

Additional Needs \$22,500,000 Current Programming \$22,823,000 Federal demonstration \$22,500,000

West Ridgecrest Blvd. widening and reconstruction from Mahan Street to China Lake Blvd. - This project was originally advanced through Board action and is currently under consideration because the environmental review is completed for the proposed project. Design, rights of way and construction are proposed in the near term should the project be funded in the augmentation. If augmentation funding is provided, construction could begin by 2009.

Other source / local \$1,150,000

<u>Laval Road Interchange upgrades at Interstate 5</u> - The County of Kern, in cooperation with Caltrans and Tejon Ranch is the sponsor for the Laval Road Interchange project at Interstate 5. Improvements to this interchange are a required mitigation for the Tejon Ranch in exchange for the improvements currently underway. This project is currently funded with private investments from the Tejon Ranch and several federal appropriations. Project design is nearly completed for this project and will start construction within the next year.

Location - Project Limits - Description and Scope of Work - (brief) (State/Region and Area Specific Maps to be included below)

In the City of Bakersfield, from Stockdale Hwy. to Truxtun Ave. at SR-99. Construct 8.1 mile, 4-lane & 6-lane freeway including four interchanges, two over crossings, three river and canal crossings, and a RR grade separation. Project currently in design phase. The federal environmental process under NEPA is complete and a FONSI was issued January 2007. In addition, the environmental process under CEQA is complete and CEQA certification was issued December 2007. Ninety percent of the right-of-way has been acquired to accommodate the ultimate freeway configuration. Acquisition of remaining 10% in progress.


Transportation Problem to be Addressed by Project and Description of Project Benefits - (brief)

Commuters from western quadrants of metropolitan Bakersfield are concentrated onto only a few east-west arterials that are viable routes from west Bakersfield to the central business district. The purpose of the project is to construct a high-capacity, east-west transportation corridor that: (1) reduces congestion on existing parallel arterials, (2) supports current and planned development in west Bakersfield; (3) improves connectivity of the existing transportation network in west Bakersfield, and (4) accommodates potential future multimodal transportation facilities.

#### Expected Source(s) of Additional Funding Necessary to Complete Project - as Identified Under 'Additional Need' - (brief)

Additional funding includes \$5 million in PUC funding already allocated. Proposed funding reflects request for STIP augmentation dollars to fully fund project.






