

IMPORTANT: 2020 Census Boundaries Update

PSAP Stakeholders Workshop

1:00pm - 3:30pm February 13th, 2019

The 2020 Census Participant Statistical Areas Program (PSAP) **120-day review period has started**, for the review and update of the census tracts, block groups, census designated places (CDPs), and census county divisions for the 2020 Census. Kern Council of Governments will be hosting a PSAP stakeholder meeting from 1:00pm - 3:30pm on Wednesday February 13th, 2019.

The 2020 Census PSAP is the only opportunity prior to the 2020 Census for regional planning agencies (RPAs); councils of governments (COGs); and tribal, state, county, and local governments **to review and update the selected statistical areas. These updated areas will be used for the next ten years to:**

- **Prepare grant applications to fund community and regional development, education, agriculture, energy, and environmental programs, as well as other needed community improvements and enhancements.**
- **Plan for future community needs. The next opportunity to review and delineate statistical areas is planned for the 2030 Census.**
