Position Summary

The successful candidate will work in coordination with our planning staff to assist in projects and studies that: support the development of the Regional Transportation Plan, Transit Plans and the planning and funding of transportation projects in the Kern region. In addition, this Regional Planner will foster relationships and collaborate with the Kern region's transit operators, planning and public works departments and partner agencies such as Caltrans.

The ideal candidate will have knowledge and experience with transit planning and transit funding programs. This position will have a salary level from the listed range dependent on qualifications and experience.

Essential Duties

- Communicate effectively with technical staff, policy makers, and the general public, including giving effective public presentations at committee, board and public meetings;
- Research and analyze federal and state funding programs;
- Research, compile, analyze and summarize statistical and technical information in written, graphic and/or oral reports, and prepare and maintain financial spreadsheets;
- Prepare clear, concise and complete technical documents, reports, grant applications and other written materials;
- Work closely with local, state and federal agencies relating to transit planning and programming transit funding;
- Coordinating and/or supervising specific planning activities and programs. Works closely with the Planning Director and Executive Director to formulate, organize, and implement various planning functions and related work as required.

Education and Experience

Graduation from a recognized college or university with a degree in planning, architecture, engineering, public administration, or related field if courses in planning have been completed as part of the program. The requirement for planning courses may be waived for those having experience in transit funding programs, planning or

community development. Experience working with transit agencies, cities or Graduate work in planning may be considered in lieu of experience.

- Principles and practices of policy planning;
- Techniques and processes involved in long-range plan and program preparation;
- Ability to write clearly and effectively and the ability to perform and coordinate complex planning activities.
