**Subject: Kern Council of Governments' Administrative Modification No. 15 to the 2021 Federal Transportation Improvement Program**

Dear Ms. Amanin, Mr. Acebo, and Ms. Kahrs:

On April 30, 2015, with the acknowledgment of the Kern Council of Governments (Kern COG) Board, the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) delegated to the Kern COG Executive Director the authority to approve Administrative Modifications to the Federal Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (FSTIP)/Federal Transportation Improvement Program (FTIP). This delegated authority is in accordance with the FSTIP/FTIP Amendment and Administrative Modification procedures.

The Kern COG Executive Director has completed review of Administrative Modification No. 15 (Modification No. 15) to the 2021 FTIP. The Executive Director finds that the proposed changes are consistent with the FTIP Amendment Policy adopted by the Kern COG Board; therefore, approves these changes. Kern COG certifies that the projects included in this modification are not included in any other amendment or modification to the 2021 FTIP currently out for public review or approval. The Kern COG staff reviewed the requests and has agreed to make administrative revisions to the 2021 FTIP reflecting changes to the projects below:

**State Highway Operation and Protection Program – KER210207**

Caltrans requests to revise the group project listing for record KER210207 Minor Program. Kern COG concurs with the request to expedite the appropriate changes as part of Modification No. 15 because: 1) there is a change to grouped project listing; and 2) there is a cost revision due to revised grouped project listing.

**Transit Program – KER180801**

The City of Delano requests to revise the group listing for record KER180801 operating assistance. Kern COG concurs with the request to expedite the appropriate changes as part of Modification No. 15 because: 1) there is a change to grouped project listing; and 2) there is a cost revision due to revised grouped project listing.

Revisions have been made to California Transportation Improvement Program (CTIPS) database and are reflected in the enclosure. This administrative modification relies on the FSTIP financial capacity. The financial constraint documentation will be updated to reflect changes made by this administrative modification in the next formal amendment. It should be noted that the changes to these projects does not require a re-determination of the air quality conformity analysis.

Under the delegated authority received from Caltrans, Administrative Modifications do not require Federal Highway Administration, Federal Transit Administration or Caltrans approval. The purpose of this letter is to notify Caltrans, the Federal Highway Administration, and Federal Transit Administration that this Administrative Modification has taken place.
