Re: Rounding Error Adjustments to the 6th Cycle RHNA Allocation Plan Requested by HCD - 12/22/22

On December 22, 2022 the Department of Housing and Community Development sent an e-mail to the Kern Council of Governments (attention: Rochelle Invina-Jayasiri) identifying certain discrepancies in the Table entitled 2023 - 2031 RHNA Allocations by Income Category presented in the 6th Cycle RHNA Allocation Plan. The discrepancies consisted of the sum of all low-income units (one less than the low-income allocation) and the sum of all moderate-income units (two less than the allocation). The KCOG Staff and Consultant Teams determined that the discrepancies resulted from the rounding of numbers across the rows/columns of the Table, which are remedied by the following adjustments:

1. Taking one moderate from California City (-1)
2. Adding one moderate to Shafter (+1)
3. Adding one moderate to Taft (+1)
4. Adding one moderate to Unincorporated (+1)
5. Adding one low to Wasco (+1)
