Subject: Kern Council of Governments' Administrative Modification No. 15 to the 2023 Federal Transportation Improvement Program

Dear Mr. Morris, Mr. Acebo, and Mr. Kang:

On April 30, 2015, with the acknowledgment of the Kern Council of Governments (Kern COG) Board, the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) delegated to the Kern COG Executive Director the authority to approve Administrative Modifications to the Federal Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (FSTIP)/Federal Transportation Improvement Program (FTIP). This delegated authority is in accordance with the FSTIP/FTIP Amendment and Administrative Modification procedures.

The Kern COG Executive Director has completed a review of Administrative Modification No. 15 (Modification No. 15) to the 2023 FTIP. The Executive Director finds that the proposed change is consistent with the FTIP Amendment Policy adopted by the Kern COG Board; therefore, approves these changes. Kern COG certifies that the projects included in this modification are not included in any other amendment or modification to the 2023 FTIP currently out for public review or approval. The Kern COG staff reviewed the requests and has agreed to make administrative revisions to the 2023 FTIP reflecting changes to the project below:

State Highway/Regional Choice Program – KER230101, KER230102

Caltrans requests to revise the group project listing for record KER230101 Interchange Reconfiguration and KER230102 Truck Climbing Lanes. Kern COG concurs with the request to expedite the appropriate changes as part of Modification No. 15 because: 1) there is no change in scope; and 2) there is no cost revision.

State Highway Operations and Protection Program – KER210202, KER210205

Caltrans requests to revise the group project listing for record KER210202 Collision Reduction Program and KER210205 Roadway Preservation Program. This update includes the 2024 SHOPP approved by the California Transportation Commission on March 22, 2024. Kern COG concurs with the request to expedite the appropriate changes as part of Modification No. 15 because: 1) there is no change in scope; and 2) there is a cost revision due to a revised grouped project listing.

Transit Program – KER230811

Golden Empire Transit District requests to revise the project description for record KER230811. Kern COG concurs with the request to expedite the appropriate changes as part of Modification No. 15 because: 1) there is no change in scope; and 2) there is no cost revision.

Revisions have been made to the California Transportation Improvement Program (CTIPS) database and are reflected in the enclosure. This administrative modification relies on the FSTIP financial capacity. The financial constraint documentation will be updated to reflect changes made by this administrative modification in the next formal amendment. It should be noted that the changes to these projects do not require a re-determination of the air quality conformity analysis.

Under the delegated authority received from Caltrans, Administrative Modifications do not require Federal Highway Administration, Federal Transit Administration or Caltrans approval. The purpose of this letter is to notify Caltrans, the Federal Highway Administration, and Federal Transit Administration that this Administrative Modification has taken place.
