FEDERAL FISCAL YEAR 2026 FEDERAL TRANSIT ADMINISTRATION  
SECTION 5311 CALL FOR PROJECTS

DESCRIPTION:

Rural agencies providing public transportation services are eligible to apply for FY 2026 funding from the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) through the Section 5311 program. Ten local agencies are eligible to apply.

DISCUSSION:

FTA requires Caltrans to manage the FTA Section 5311 Grant program in California. Caltrans notified Kern COG staff that the FY 2026 FTA Section 5311 Regional apportionment will total \$2,232,538. Kern COG staff has prepared a FY 2026 5311 Program of Projects to identify specific agency apportionments. Eligible agencies were notified via e-mail of their specific apportionment on June 16, 2026 and have been requested to submit their local match amounts for the FY 2026 5311 Program funds at their earliest convenience but no later than 12 p.m., Wednesday, July 22, 2026.

**DESCRIPTION:**

Upcoming amendment schedule for next 2025 FTIP Amendment.

The upcoming amendment will include revisions to the State Highway Operations and Protection Program, Transit Program, and will add the Federal Lands Highway Transportation Improvement Program.
